  - Larry Strong presented a power point on the Budget Structure, Budget Goals, Estimation of Revenue, Expenses & Development Budget Cycle. The power point presentation was sent out to the committee.
    - Larry is willing to go to any committee, department, or employee to explain and answer budget questions.
    - Romana asked if there would be any COVID Funds carried over to FY 25. Larry did not think there would be any.
    - Joel asked if the district received the full 8.22% for Cola in FY 24. Larry stated that we did.
      - Larry explained that the Cola is not just for salaries, it covers all expense increases.
      - Joel stated that faculty do not think they are getting their part of the Cola and would like more information on management salaries for all.
    - Steve stated that the budget committee needs to work on a Principle and Guidelines for when there are increases or decreases in the budgets. Casey agreed.
    - Romana stated that we are just trusting the process and not making sure it is being followed and there needs to be transparency through the whole process.
