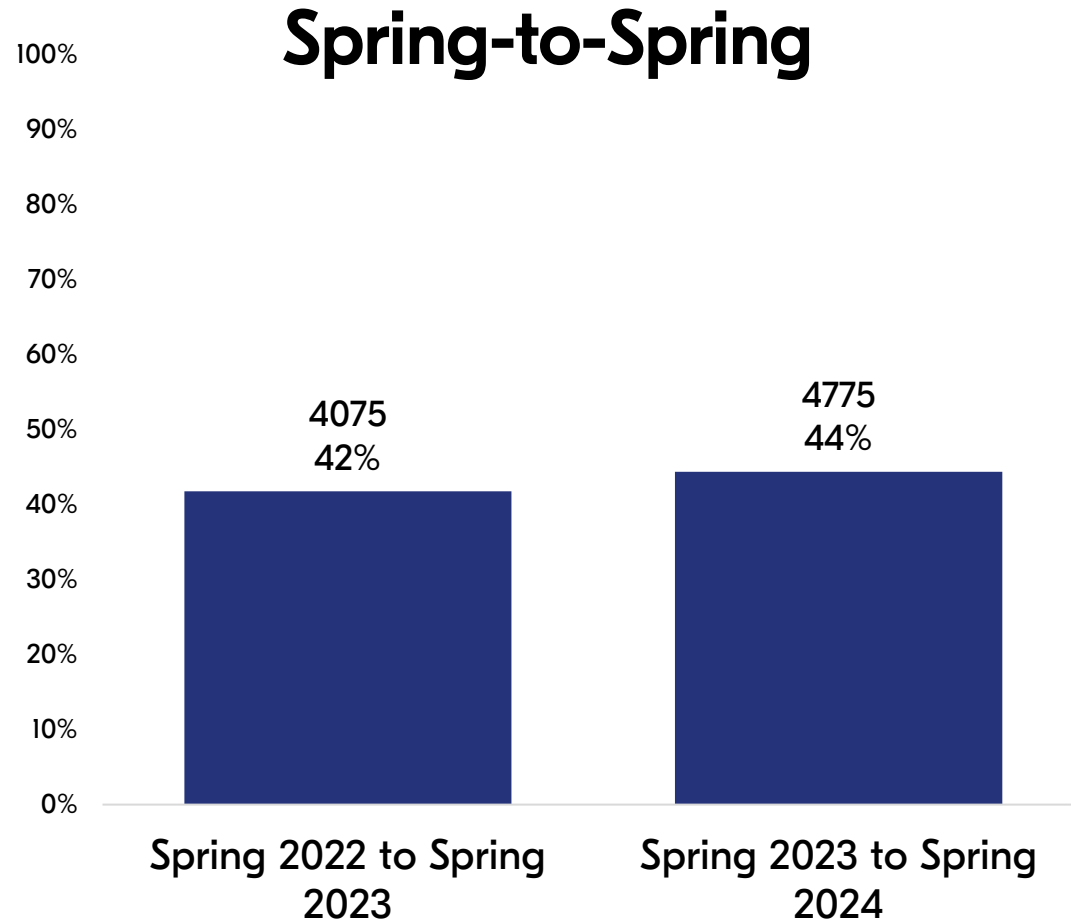

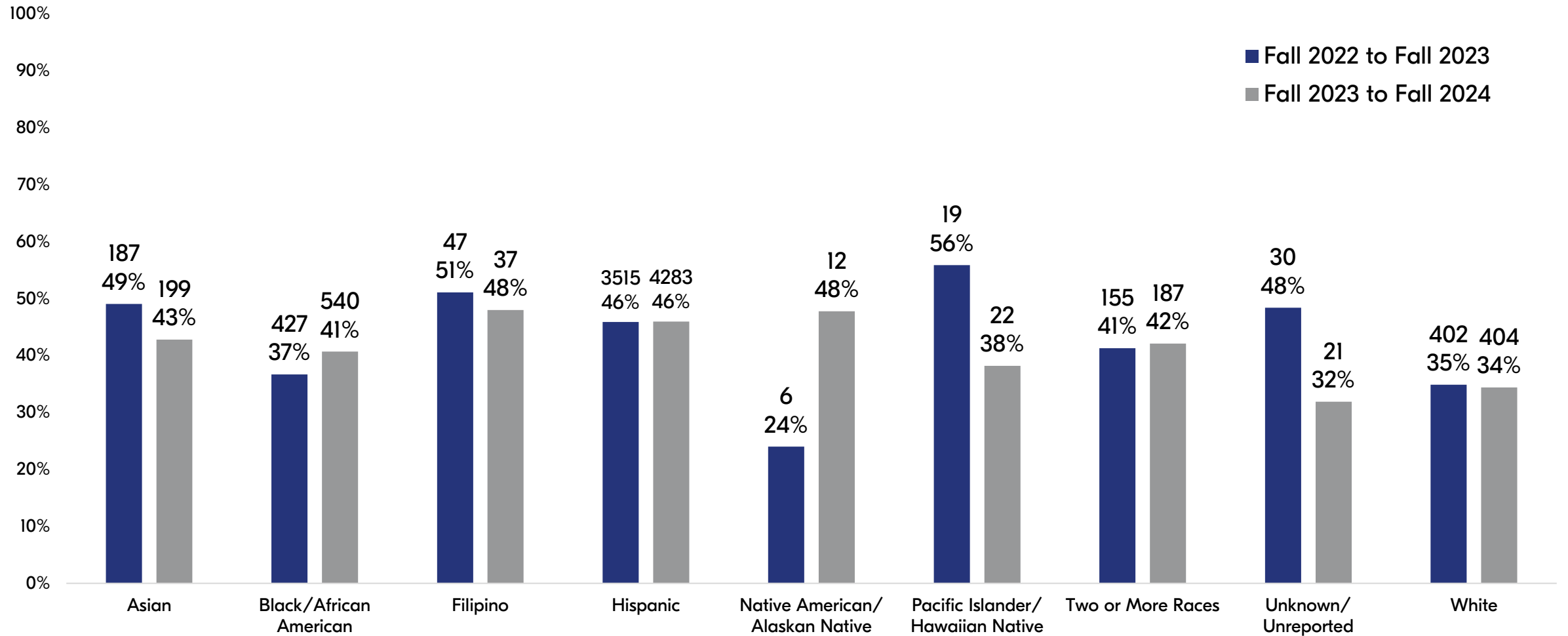

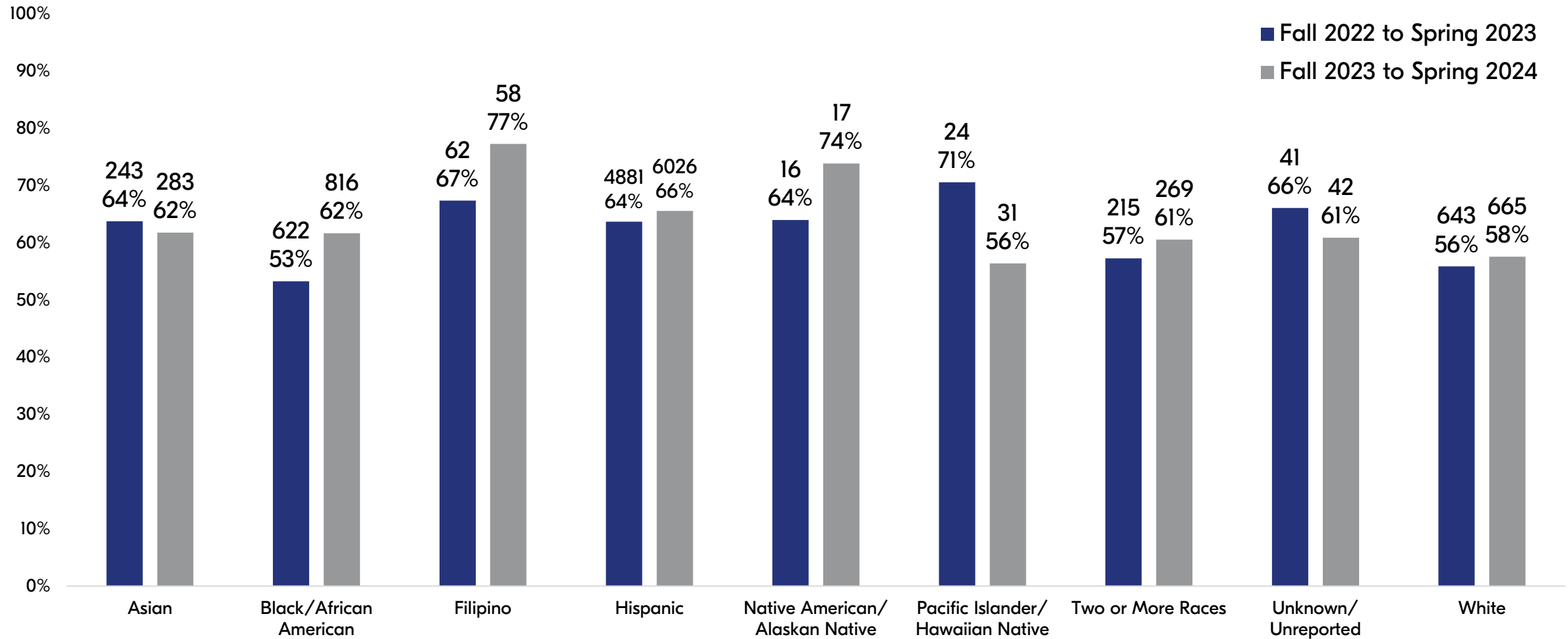

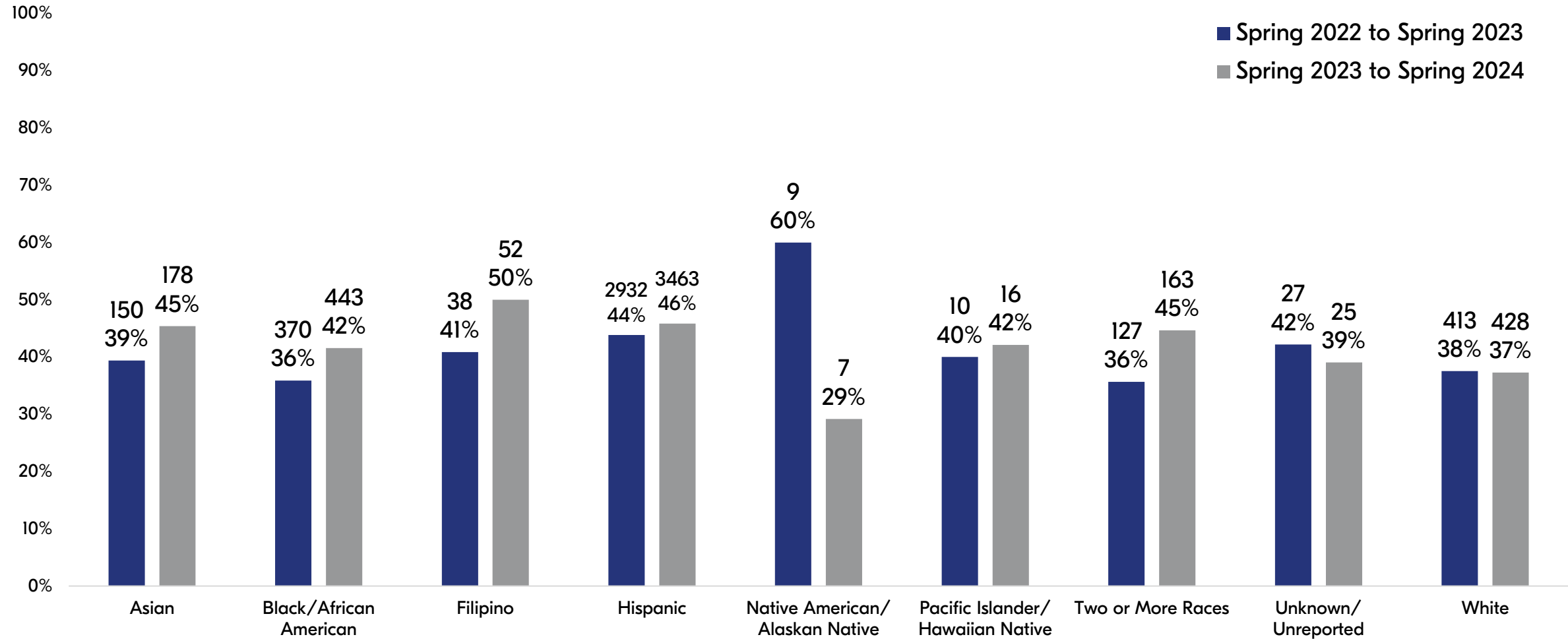
# FALL-TO-FALL PERSISTENCE RATES BY RACE

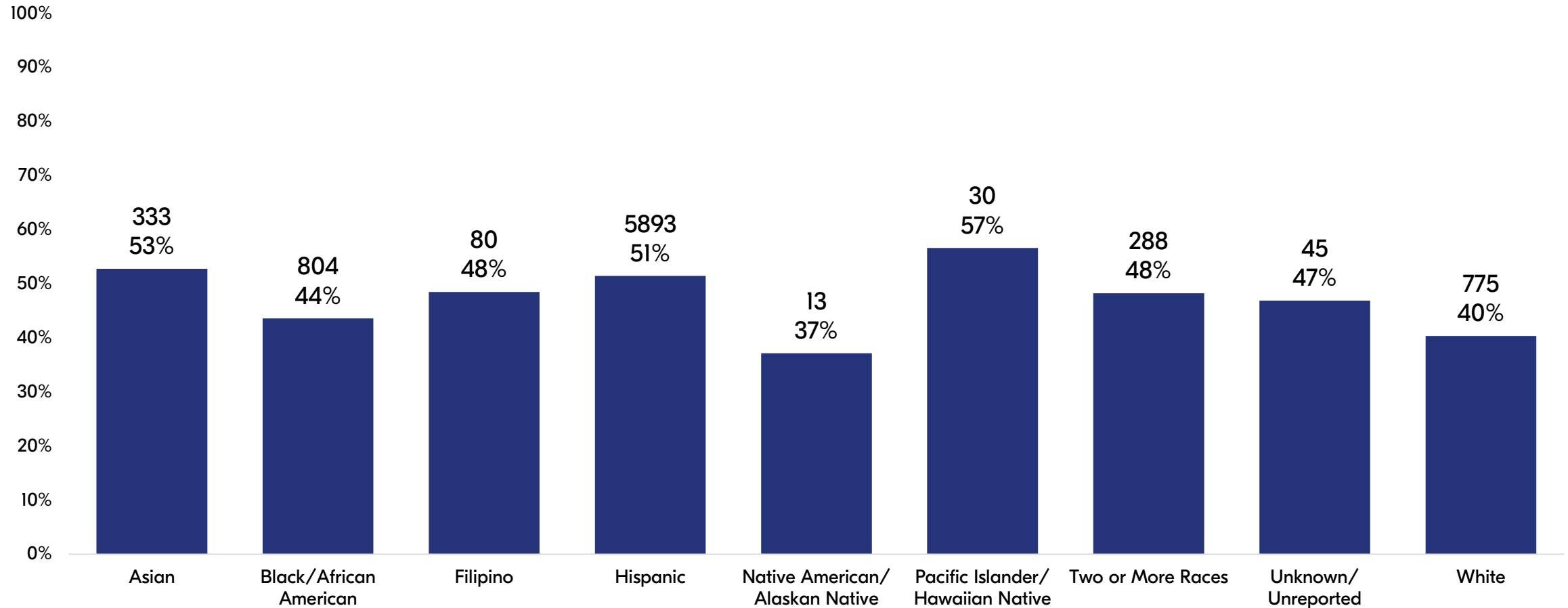

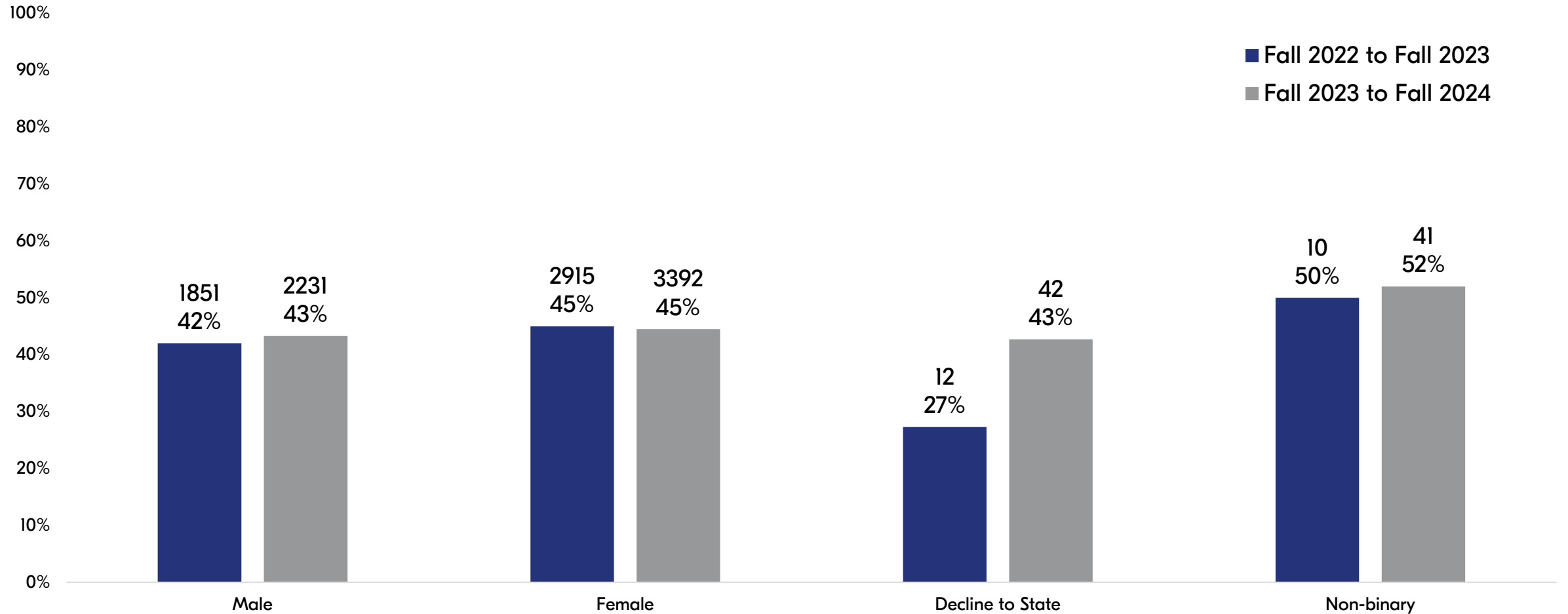

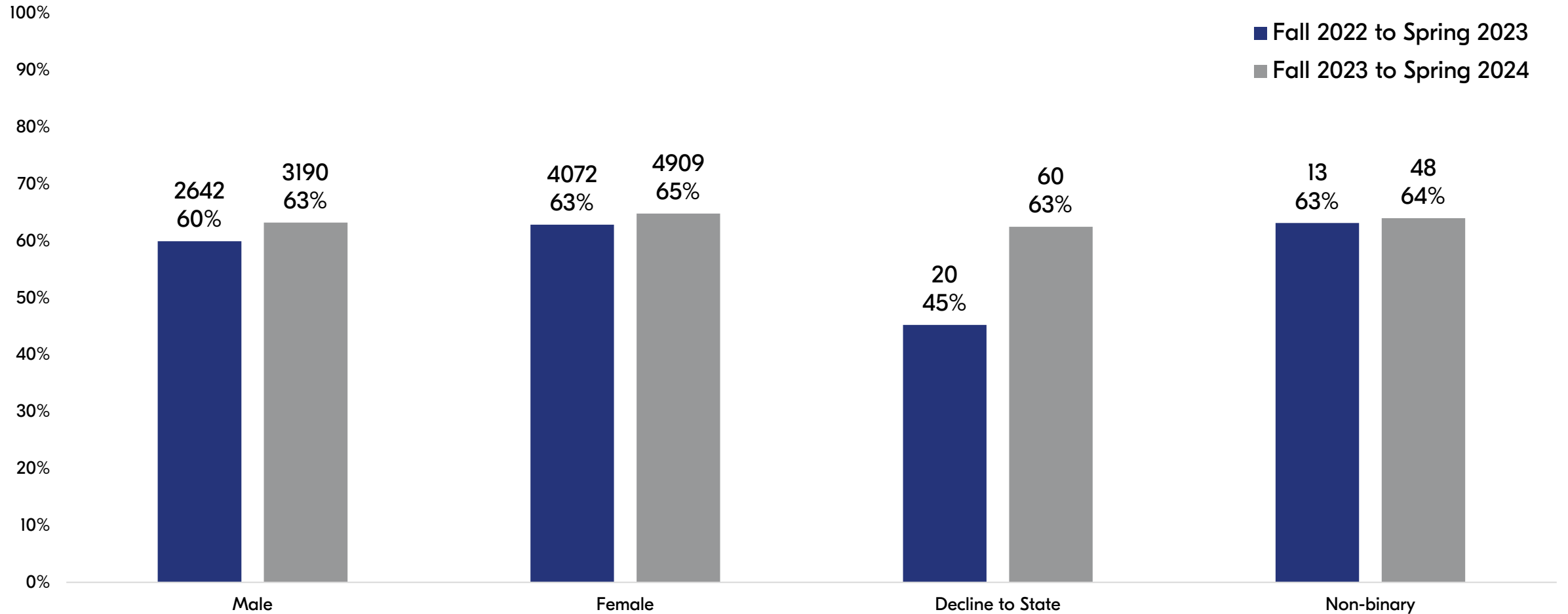


# FALL-TO-FALL PERSISTENCE RATES BY GENDER IDENTITY

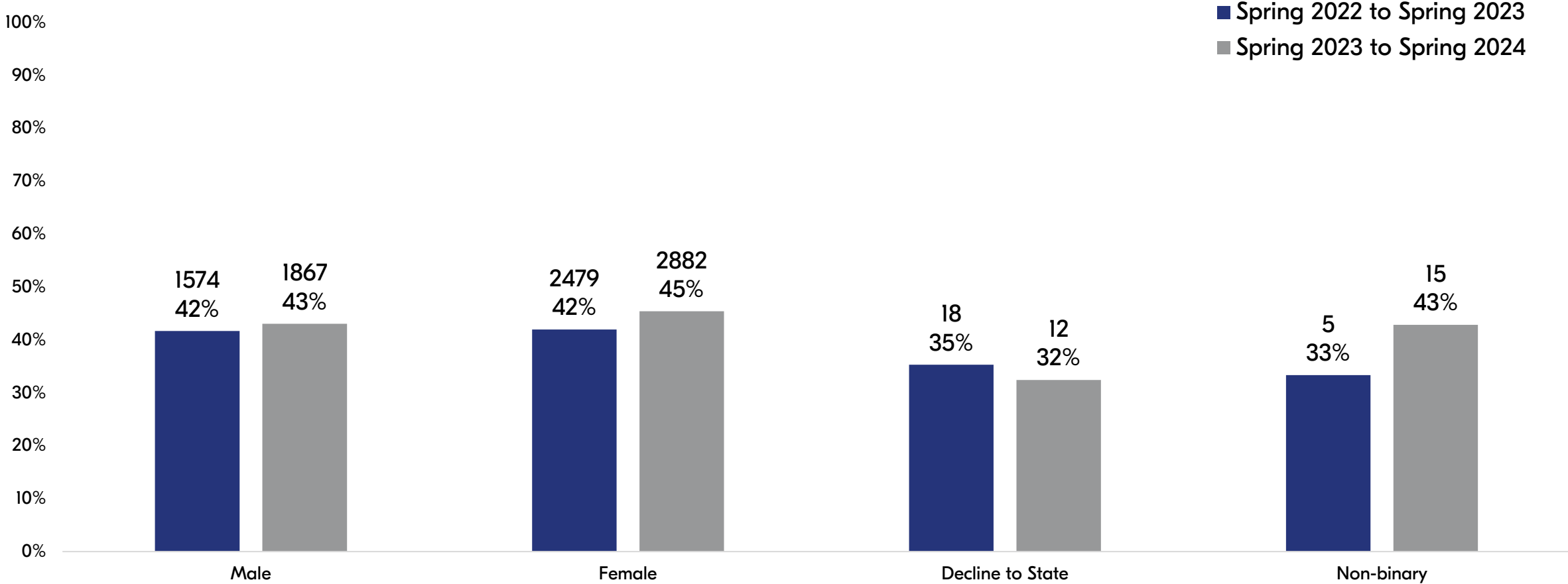

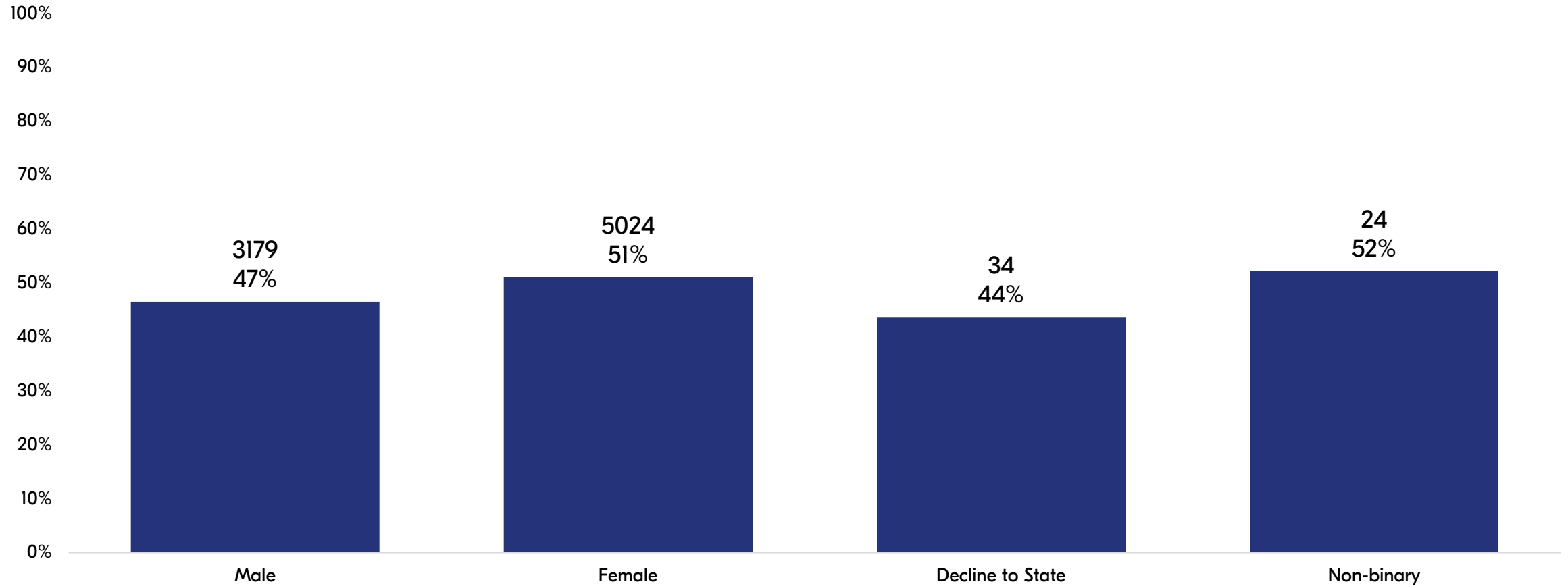

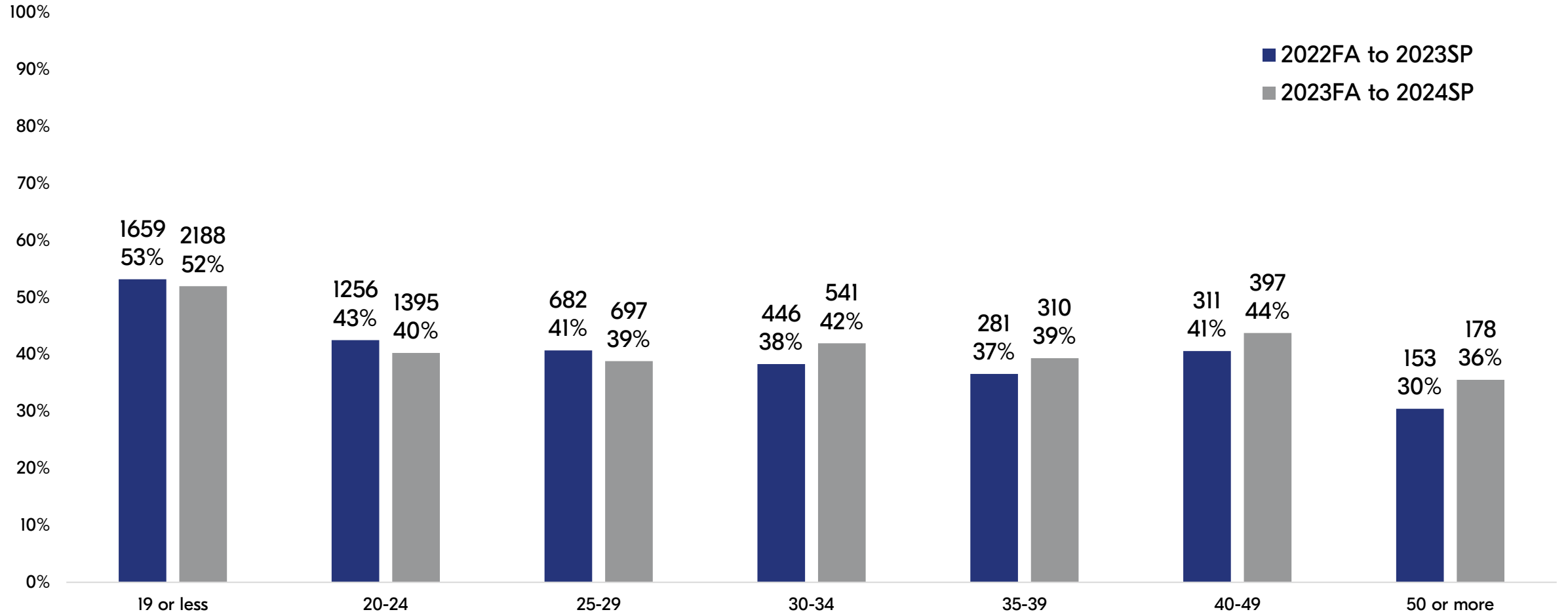

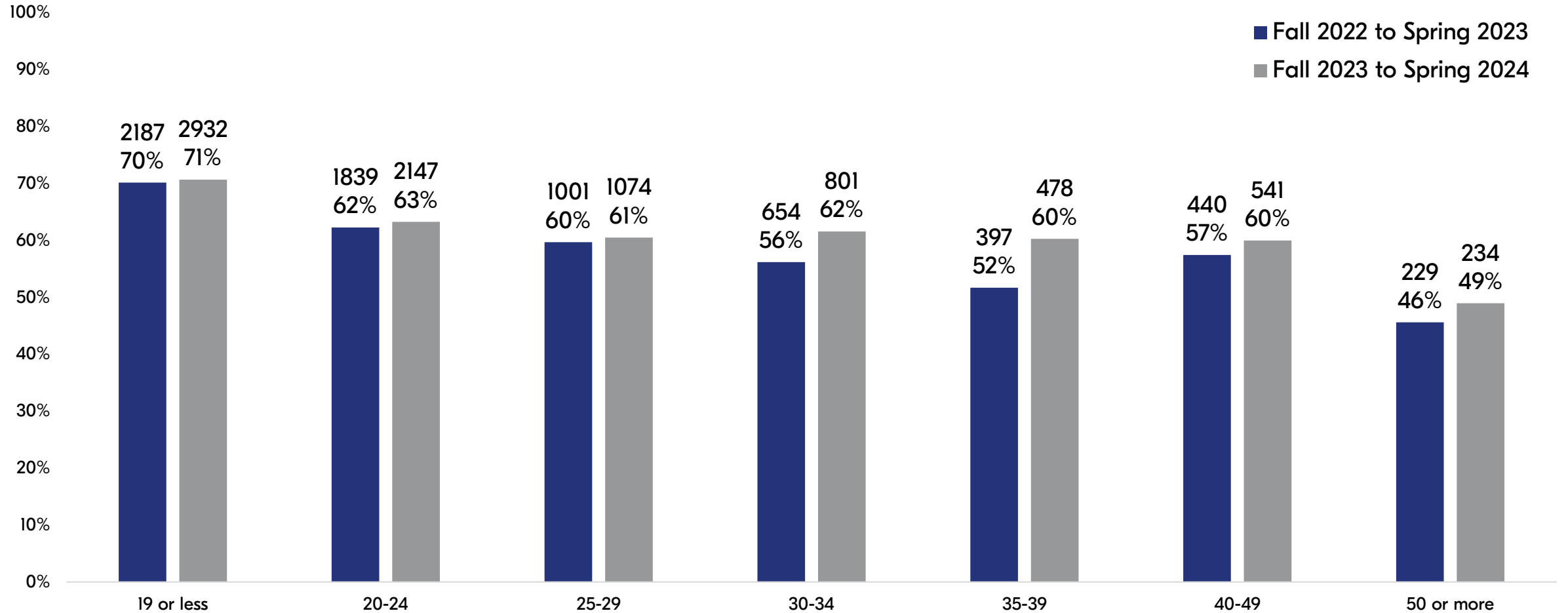

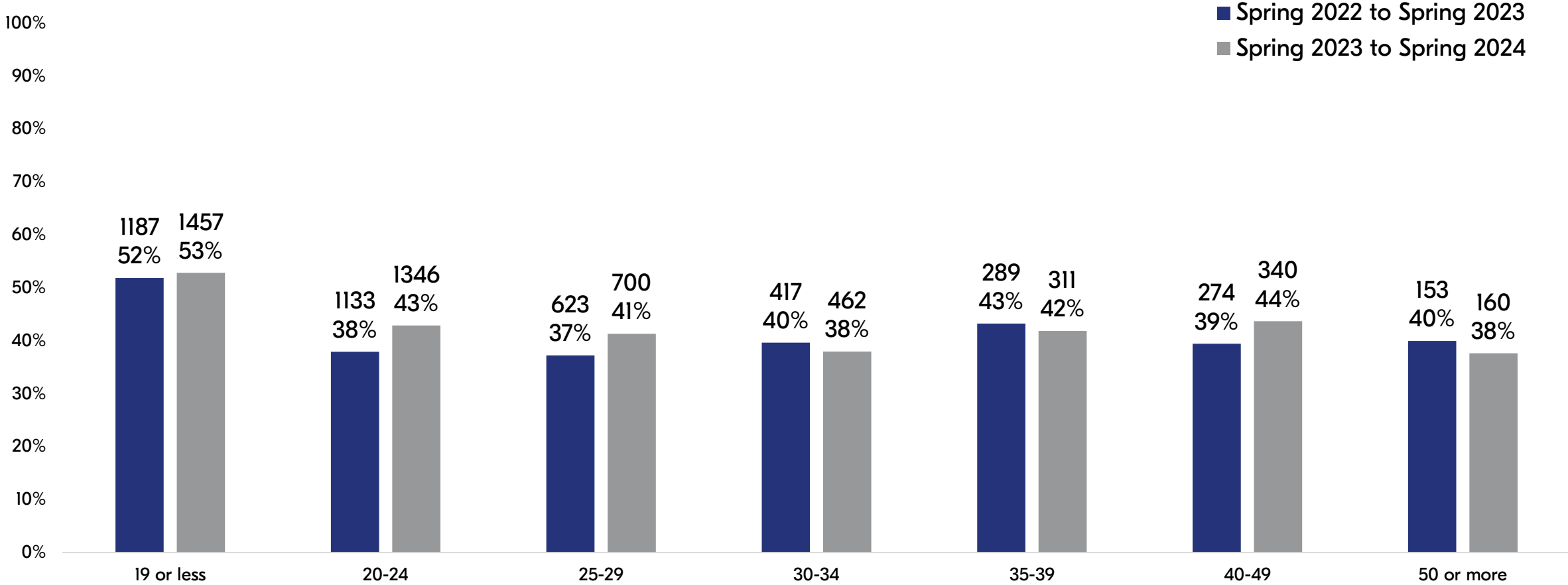
# FALL-TO-FALL PERSISTENCE RATES BY AGE GROUP

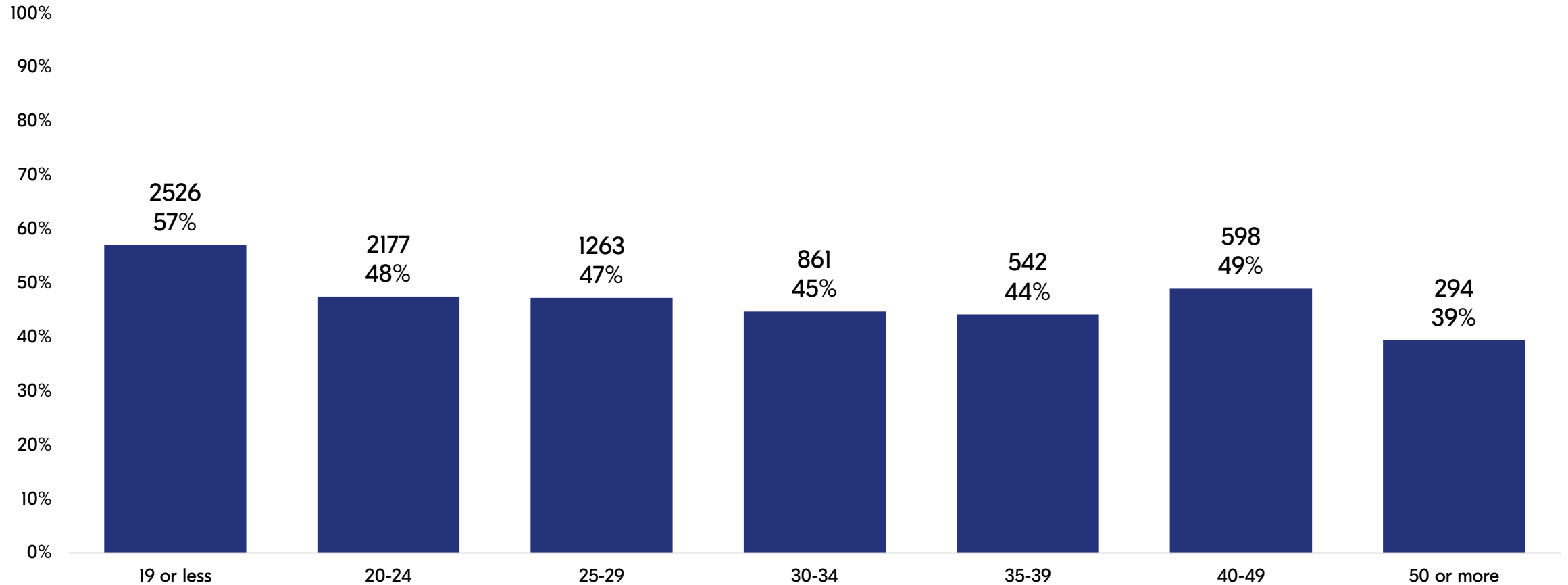

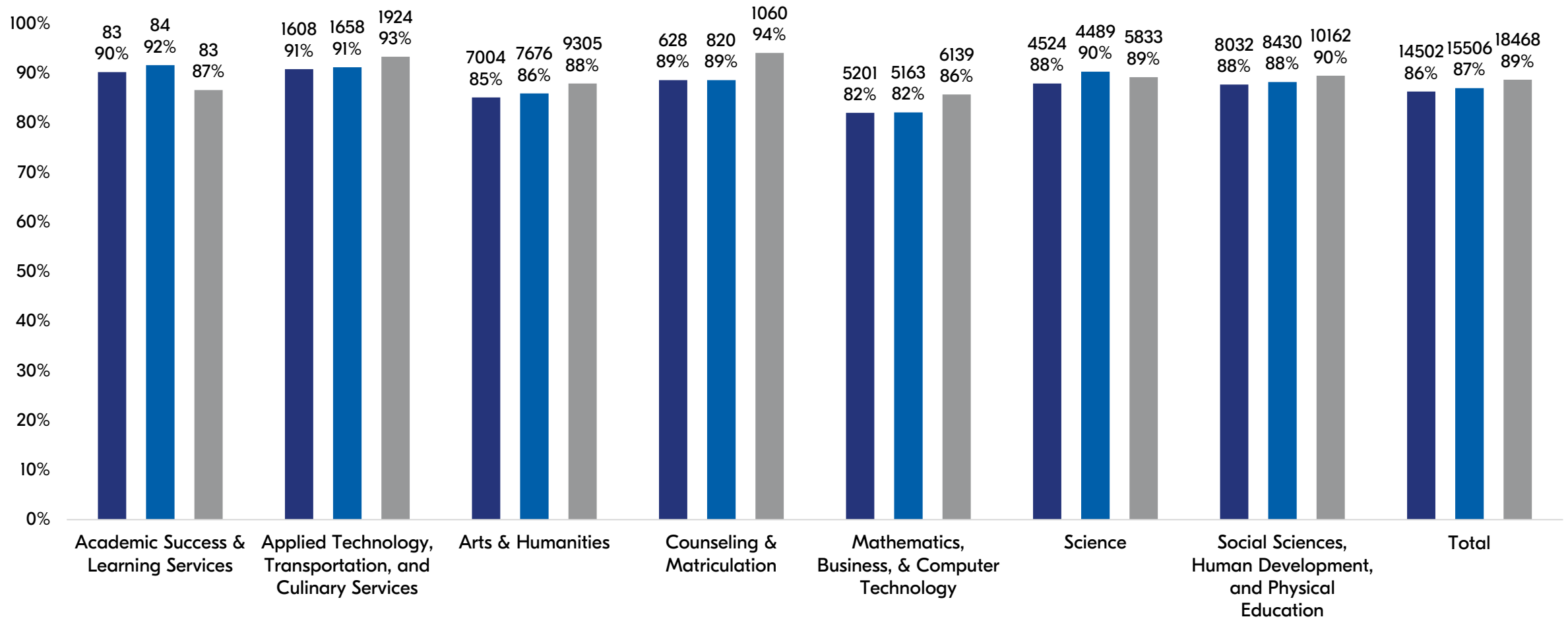

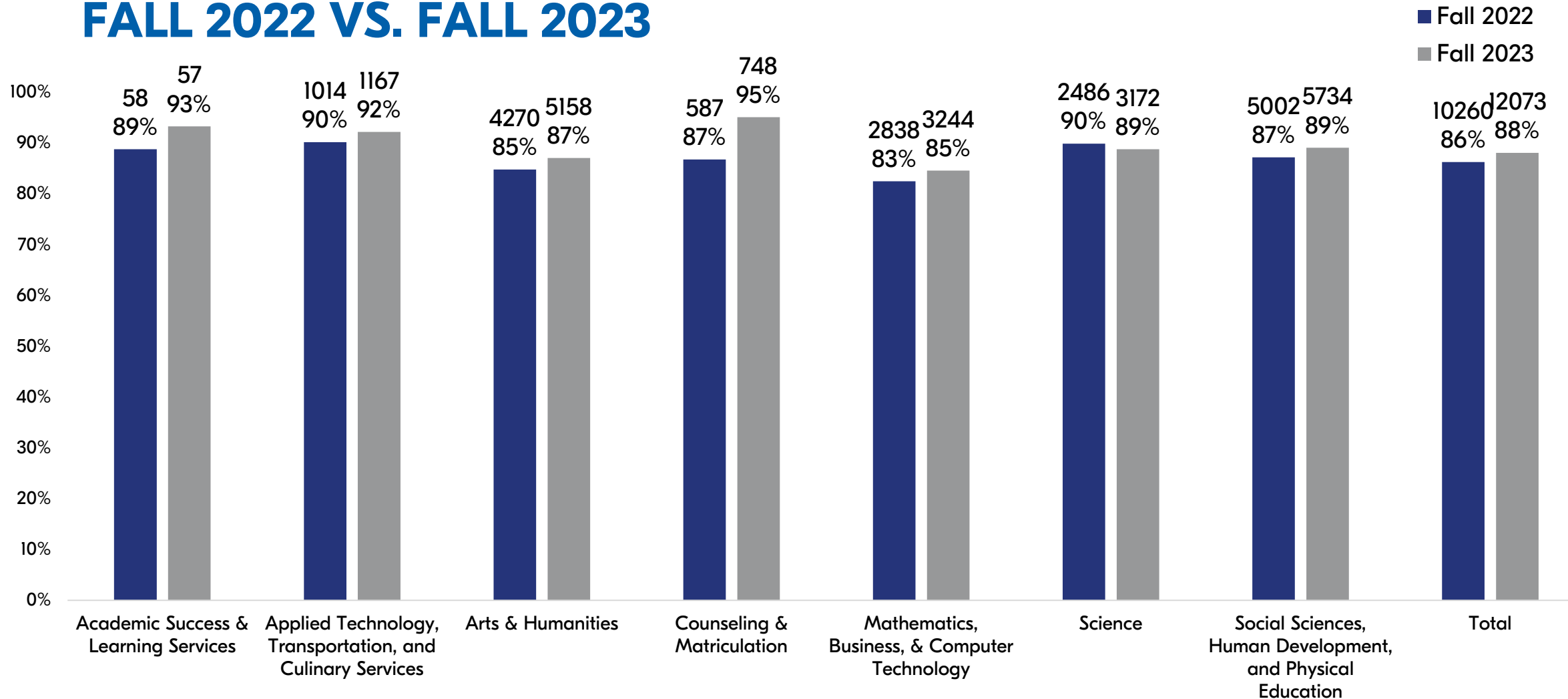

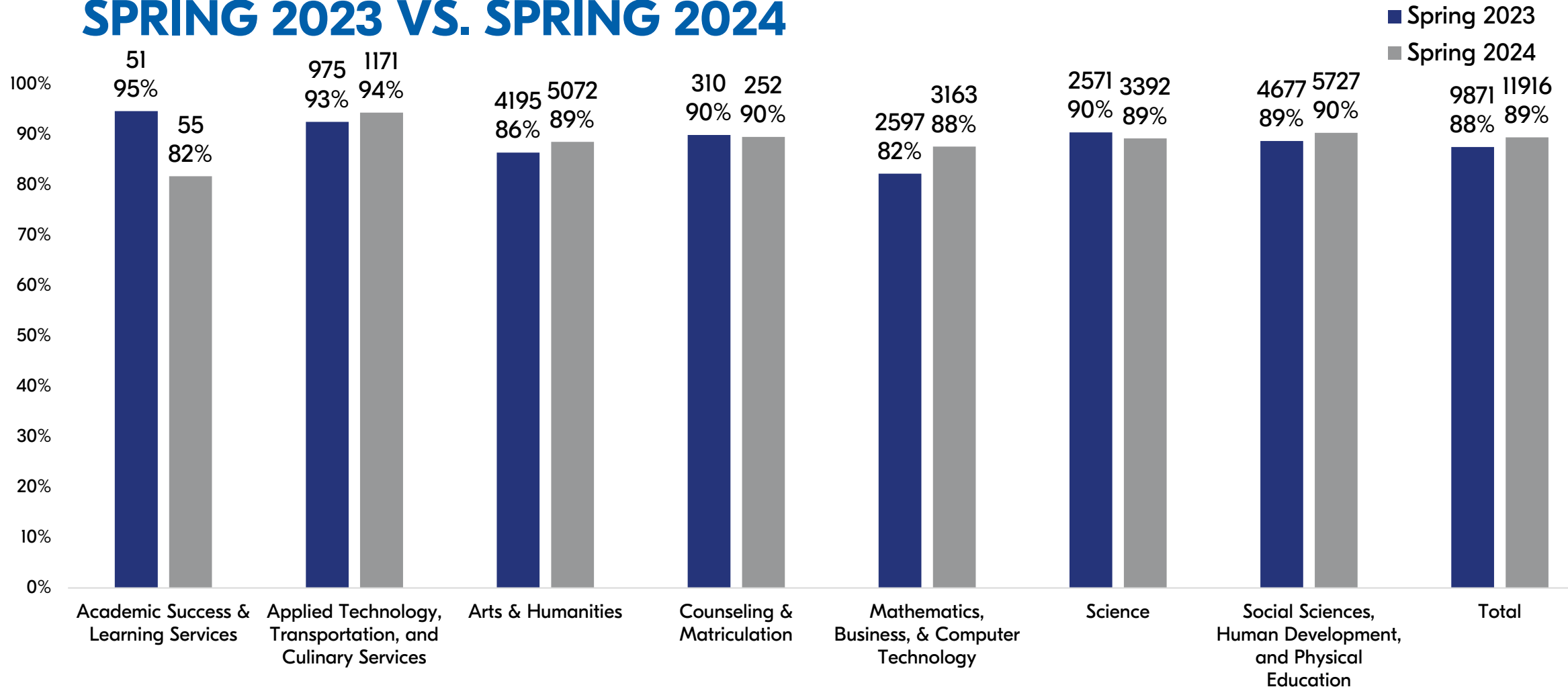
